## REVIEW

The mission of the Illinois Racing Board is to regulate pari-mutuel horse racing and support the development of the equine industry. Horse racing is an economic asset to the State of Illinois. The racing and breeding industries are important to the state's economy and agribusiness. The goals of the IRB are to advance a regulatory environment that benefits the equine industry and ensure that the public has confidence in the integrity of pari-mutuel horse racing.

Illinois' three pari-mutuel racetracks conducted a combined total of 266 live race dates in 2018, compared to 249 in 2017. Arlington Park conducted 71 live thoroughbred race dates, compared to the same number of days in 2017. Fairmount Park conducted 36 live thoroughbred race dates, compared to 40 in 2017. Hawthorne Race Course conducted 54 live thoroughbred race compared to 58 in dates. 2017.Suburban Downs at Hawthorne Race Course conducted 105live standardbred race dates compared to 80 in 2017.

In 2017.the Board approved transferring \$500,000 of its excess operating funds to Illinois' three parimutuel racetracks (four licensees) to increase purses and promote Illinois horse racing. Distributed in 2018. Suburban Downs, Arlington Park, Hawthorne Race Course. and Fairmount Park used these funds to supplement purses for races for Illinois-bred horses.

The Board published a Notice of Funding Opportunity ("NOFO") for its

Illinois Racing Charity Grant. pursuant to the Illinois Grant Accountability and Transparency Act. The Board received one application for this Grant. Pursuant to Section 31.1 of the Illinois Horse Racing Act, the Board approved a Grant for 2019 in the amount of \$860,319 to the Racing Industry Charitable Foundation, Inc.

In 2018, the Illinois handle on all racing was \$573,501,684 (274 race programs) compared to \$586,691,745 in 2017 (257 race programs). A decrease of 2.2%. In 2018, the total handle for advance deposit wagering (ADW) was \$206,034,006 compared to \$190,284,417 in 2017. An increase of 7.6%.

A total of \$34,506,118 was distributed in purses in 2018. Total thoroughbred purses were \$25,421,817 (161 race programs) compared to \$25,024,819 in 2017 (169 race programs). Arlington Park averaged \$240,360 per program, Hawthorne Race Course, \$114,236 and Fairmount Park averaged \$60,765. Total standardbred purses were \$9,084,301 (113)race programs) compared to \$8,768,531 in 2017 (88 race programs). Suburban Downs at Hawthorne Race Course averaged \$79.096 per program.

At the annual Dates Hearing in September, the Board approved for 2019, 71 live thoroughbred race dates to Arlington Park, 52 live thoroughbred race dates to Hawthorne Race Course, and 41 live thoroughbred race dates to Fairmount Park. Suburban Downs at Hawthorne Race Course was awarded 71 live harness race dates.

## **LEGISLATIVE INTENT**

The Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975 is intended to benefit the people of the State of Illinois by assisting economic development and promoting Illinois tourism. The General Assembly finds and declares it to be the public policy of the State of Illinois to:

1. Support and enhance Illinois' horse racing industry, which is a significant component within the agribusiness industry. Sections 30 and 31 of the Act promote the breeding, buying and racing of thoroughbred and standardbred horses in Illinois. preserving the agribusiness segment of the Illinois Purse economy. supplements, owner and breeders awards are paid to owners and breeders of winning horses in certain races limited to Illinois conceived and foaled horses.

2. Ensure that Illinois' horse racing industry remains competitive with neighboring states. Through the rulemaking process, the Board creates new rules and amends existing rules to be more uniform, consistent, and competitive with other major racing jurisdictions. IRB staff members and industry representatives are continually working to update the administrative rules.

3. Stimulate growth within Illinois' horseracing industry, thereby encouraging new investment and development to produce additional tax revenues and to create additional jobs. The Board strives to foster an environment that creates jobs and generates important revenue to the State of Illinois by encouraging racetracks to make use of their vacant off-track wagering licenses.

4. Promote the further growth of tourism. To ensure that adequate funds are devoted to the marketing of horse racing, the Board requires that each applicant for licensure to operate a race meet submit a proposed advertising and promotional budget during the licensing process.

5.Encourage the breeding of thoroughbred and standardbred horses in this State. Pursuant to the Act. breeders awards have been established promote the breeding of to thoroughbreds. standardbreds, and quarter horses by Illinois residents.

Ensure that public confidence 6. and trust in the credibility and integrity of racing operations and the regulatory process ismaintained. Public confidence is essential to a vital horse racing industry. The licensing of all persons participating in pari-mutuel racing and the testing of post-race samples equine necessarv are components of the Board's regulatory program. Urine and blood samples are obtained post-race from the winner of every race, the horses finishing second and third in stakes races, and from any other horses selected by the stewards based on current and past performance.

## **REGULATORY CHANGES**

The following administrative rules were amended during 2018:

**Part 510**. Claiming Races – effective March 26, 2018. Section 250(a) requires that for a period of 20 days after the claim of a thoroughbred horse. it shall not start in a race in which the eligibility price is less than 25% more than the price at which it was claimed. For a period of 10 days thereafter, a thoroughbred horse is eligible to run back for the same claiming price or higher. Section 250(b) states that these requirements shall not apply to "starter handicap" races but was amended to also exclude "starter allowance" races.

**Part 603**, *Medication* – effective June 1, 2018. Amended Section 60 to reference the most recent Association of Racing Commissioners International (ARCI) Uniform Classification Guidelines for Foreign Substances version, 13.4 dated January 9, 2018. Amended Section 75 to update the thresholds for caffeine and theobromine, pursuant to the thresholds contained in the ARCI Endogenous, Dietary, or Environmental Substances Schedule.

**Part 1313,** *General Licensee Rules* – effective June 28, 2018. Amended Section 70 to reduce the detention time for harness horses reporting to the paddock from 4 hours to 3 hours. This change did not apply to horses on lasix.

**Part 422**, Approval of Racing Officials – effective November 1, 2018. Amended several sections to reflect current practices.

**Part 502**, *Licensing* – effective November 1, 2018. Section 500(b) was amended to adopt the ARCI model rule governing jockey agents by expanding representation from two jockeys to also including an apprentice jockey.

## **LEGISLATION**

The following statutes were amended during 2018:

**Public Act 100-0627** (Senate Bill 3452) amended the Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975 effective July 20, 2018. Extended the authorization for advance deposit wagering (ADW) through December 31, 2020.

**Public Act 100-0777** (*House Bill 5459*) amended the Illinois Horse Racing Act

of 1975 effective August 10, 2018. The following changes are effective until January 1, 2022: Provides that "Illinois conceived and foaled", as the term applies to a standardbred, includes a standardbred horse whose sire is a qualified Illinois stallion. Provides that semen from a stallion qualified for the Illinois Standardbred Breeders Fund may be transported outside the State. Removes the requirement that for a horse to qualify for an Illinois conceived and foaled race the mare must be in the State at least 30 days before foaling or remain in the State at least 30 days at the time of foaling. Removes the requirement that for a horse to qualify for an Illinois conceived and foaled race the mare must be inseminated within the State and the foal must be dropped in the State. Provides that the Director of Agriculture or his or her authorized shall not publish agent notice announcing disgualification of а stallion or his foals on the basis that the stallion owner, manager, or person associated has knowingly participated in the arrangements for transporting semen from a standardbred stallion

registered under the Act out of State. Provides that a foal conceived by transported semen (rather than transported fresh semen) may be eligible for Illinois conceived and foaled registration.

**Public Act 100-1152** (Senate Bill 3387) amended the Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975 effective December 14, 2018. Made changes concerning the distribution of purses from interstate simulcast wagers for non-host licensees who derive their licenses from Fairmount Park

### **OVERVIEW**

**Commissioners and Administrative Staff:** Section 4 of the Illinois Horse Racing Act states that "the Board shall consist of 11 members to be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate, not more than 6 of whom shall be of the same political party, and one of whom shall be designated by the Governor to be chairman." As of March 1, 2019, one seat on the Board is vacant.

Racing **Regulation:** Illinois currently has three pari-mutuel racetracks in operation. In 1981, Arlington International Racecourse, located in Arlington Heights, was the site of the first thoroughbred race with a million-dollar purse, the Arlington The premier event at Million. Arlington is the International Festival of Racing which features a trio of Grade 1 stakes races on turf. Fairmount Park, opened in 1925 and located in Collinsville, hosts thoroughbred racing and did conduct harness racing up until 1999. Hawthorne Race Course, located in Stickney, conducts both thoroughbred and harness racing and is the oldest continually run familyowned racetrack in North America. Pari-mutuel harness racing also takes place at the Illinois State Fair in Springfield, the DuQuoin State Fair, and the Brown County Fair in Mt. Sterling.

Pari-mutuel wagers can be placed at each of the racetracks, the 24 off-track wagering facilities operated by the racetracks, as well as through advance deposit wagering (ADW). ADW is a method of pari-mutuel wagering placed on an electronic device in which an individual may establish an account, deposit money into the account, and use the account balance to pay for parimutuel wagering authorized under the Act.

The Board has a full-time staff of employees charged with conducting its daily functions. In addition to these full-time employees, the Board employs per-diem employees. Many of these part-time and seasonal employees only work on days when racing is conducted. The IRB employs racing officials to represent the Board at the various racetracks (e.g. stewards and horse identifiers). In addition, the Board approves the following racing officials which are employed by the racetracks: General Manager, Association Steward, Racing Secretary, Assistant Racing Secretary, Paddock Judge, Patrol Judge, Placing Judge, Starter, Clerks of Scales, Track Veterinarian, Mutuel Manager, Director of Security, Track Superintendent, Outrider, Program Director, and Timer.

All persons participating in parimutuel racing under the jurisdiction of the IRB are required to be licensed. prospective licensee Each is fingerprinted. The Board may in its discretion deny a license to any person who has been convicted of a crime, who is unqualified to perform the duties required of the applicant, who fails to states any disclose or falsely information in the application, who has been found guilty of a violation of the Act or the rules, or whose license has been suspended, revoked, or denied in another jurisdiction. A license is valid for the calendar year in which it is issued (all licenses expire on December 31<sup>st</sup>.) unless suspended or revoked under administrative regulations promulgated by the Board. The licensing department maintains an office located at the central office in Chicago and is present at all parimutuel racetracks prior to and during the opening of live race meetings in order to process license applications and collect fees.

Stewards exercise immediate supervision, control and regulation of live racing at each licensed race meeting on behalf of the IRB. The powers of the stewards include authority over all horses and all persons, licensed or unlicensed, on association grounds during each race meeting as to all matters relating to racing. The stewards conduct hearings and issue determinations of all questions. disputes. protests, complaints or objections concerning racing which arise during a race meeting and are responsible for issuing decisions or rulings pertaining to racing. As a matter of course, the stewards review the films of each race before the results are posted "official." The State Stewards are employees of the Board and the Association Stewards are employees of each racing association.

State Veterinarians supervise the operations of the test barn, the collection of urine and blood samples for testing. preparation and documentation of the biologic samples that are transported to the laboratory. administration of race and dav furosemide injections by IRB approved veterinarians. The State Veterinarians also oversee all regulatory veterinary activities associated with live racing: pre-race examinations: race-dav furosemide administrations: on-track monitoring of horse health and soundness; triage of racing injuries; and management of the veterinarians' list of horses determined to be ineligible to race for medical reasons. The State Veterinarians are employees of the Board and the Association Veterinarians are employees of each racing association.

IRB security personnel conduct investigations to determine the fitness of applicants for licensing, perform drug and alcohol testing on licensees pursuant to the administrative rules, collaborate with racetrack security, work with other racing jurisdictions to monitor licensee activity, and conduct investigations into alleged violations of the Act and administrative rules.

To ensure integrity and for the protection of the public, the Board regulates all pari-mutuel wagering, monitors pari-mutuel handle and takeout, and ensures the proper allocation and distribution of revenue generated by pari-mutuel wagering.

## Laboratory

Over the past year the University of Illinois at Chicago Analytical Forensic Testing Laboratory has conducted one of the most comprehensive equine drug testing programs in the country. The laboratory adjusted the blood screening method to encompass more compounds as well as reduce testing times by LC-MS-MS analysis. This is beneficial since more compounds require screening and quantification per IRB rules.

The laboratory continues to assist the track stewards and security personnel in investigating possible doping violations that employ methods designed to circumvent our standard testing procedures. The laboratory also investigates and reports on special items such as syringes, drug vials and other contraband that are collected or seized at the racetracks.

The laboratory went through a full ISO 17025 on-site inspection in 2018 with no major deficiencies and received full re-accreditation. The laboratory continues to be RMTC accredited as well. The laboratory successfully completed the International Proficiency Testing Program conducted by the Association of Official Racing Chemists with a score of 100%.





## 2018 Total Illinois Wagering by Source





#### 2018 ADVANCE DEPOSIT WAGERING

Advance Deposit Wagering (ADW) officially began in Illinois on October 13, 2009. Five companies were licensed in 2018 as ADW providers (\*Bet America was acquired by Twin Spires in 2017). Illinois patrons place funds into an account and then wager on races using a telephone or internet device such as a computer or smartphone. Each ADW provider must have an agreement with an Illinois racetrack and their affiliated horsemen's association.

#### PURSE RECAPTURE

Purse recapture is a 1995 provision of the law that allows racetracks to recoup losses on live handle brought on by the authorization of full-card simulcasting of races from other states. The recapture amount is 2% of the decrease of Illinois handle on Illinois races from 1994. The recapture monies allocated to the racetracks are deducted from the purse accounts. In 1999, legislation was passed that authorized annual appropriations to the Department of Agriculture for reimbursement to purse accounts equal to the recapture amounts. The appropriation is an annual decision. The racetracks will always

receive their monies either from the State or from the originally intended purse accounts. Below are the annual amounts of purse recapture since 1995, when full card was authorized.
