Section 411.10 Reports

Section

The organization licensee, conducting the first meeting of each type of racing at each race track, shall provide the Board with scientific reports on the construction, elevations and surface composition of the track's training and racing surfaces. The reports shall be filed with the Board within seven days after the opening of the meet and shall be mandatory.

- a) during the first year after the adoption of this rule and
- b) whenever there is substantial renovation of a training or racing surface.

Section 411.20 Standards

The Board shall develop standards and criteria for adequate and proper equipment to maintain training and racing surfaces, and for sufficient trained personnel to properly operate such equipment. In developing these standards, the Board shall consider all relevant factors including, but not limited to, the size of the race track, the time of year in which the racing is conducted, and the type of racing conducted. The Board shall also consult with and solicit the opinions of representatives of horsemen, jockeys and other interested parties.

Section 411.30 Daily Records

ILLINOIS RACING BOARD

NOTICE OF ADOPTED REPEALER

Each thoroughbred organization licensee shall maintain daily records on the condition of each training and racing surface which shall be kept in a location on the race track which is convenient to the public, horsemen and the Board. Such records shall be open for inspection during training and racing hours.

Section 411.40 Surface Conversions and Protection

At each race track where both thoroughbred and harness racing dates have been allocated for any one year, the owner of the race track or his lessee shall, at the conclusion of one type of meet, promptly convert the racing surface for use in the other type of racing, except where a racing surface is being used for training of the first type in which case a reasonable delay of conversion will be permitted. Whenever the thoroughbred cushion is removed any portion which is to be reused shall be covered or otherwise protected from the adverse effects of weather.
